Re: Changes to MAE Exercise Science Secondary Content Area

The following changes in the Exercise Science secondary content area of the MAE have been approved by the Exercise Science and MAE faculties:

1. Eliminate the parenthetical statement indicating that ES 502 and ES 503 are both required for teacher certification. This statement is no longer applicable because ES 503 is no longer required in the secondary content area as it has been replaced by ES 363.
2. ES 503 should be replaced with ES 363 which will be taken as a core elective by Exercise Science students pursuing the Physical Education specialization.
3. Remove the "Select six hours from the following" comment and all the courses that follow. The newly revised Physical Education and Health specialization coupled with the revised courses in the secondary content area now provide sufficient hours to meet with state certification and MAE requirements.
