

Temporary Assistant Professor of Nursing (Annually Renewable)

Truman State University is seeking nursing faculty for one, temporary, full-time position for its CCNE-accredited BSN Program. Teaching responsibilities may include nursing content and clinical areas such as psychiatric/mental health, pediatric, adult health, and/or other areas as needed. Position to commence August 20, 2007

Temporary Full-Time (non-tenure eligible) position: Full-time position may be annually renewed (depending on the needs of the program) for a period not to exceed four years. Temporary full-time position responsibilities include teaching, professional and service activities, student advisement, and participation in Program and University committees.

Required qualifications:

- Master's degree in nursing with two years of recent experience as a registered nurse
- Eligibility for unrestricted Missouri registered nurse license
- Strong communication skills

Preferred qualifications:

- Nursing specialization in pediatric, psychiatric/mental health, adult health, and/or Family or Pediatric Nurse Practitioner. In the absence of a candidate with specialization in pediatric, psychiatric/mental health, or adult health nursing, other specialties will be considered depending on the needs of the Program.
- Demonstrated potential for teaching effectiveness
